

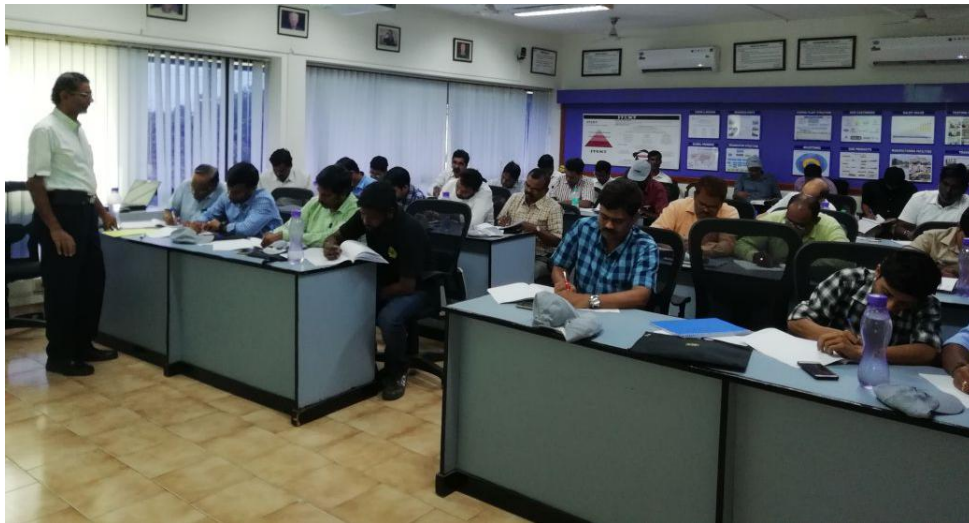
**Workshop On
How to Improve Business Competitiveness through Kobetsu Kaizen (KK)
Methodology of TPM**

The objective & aim of **Kobetsu Kaizen** or the **Focused Improvement** pillar of TPM addresses both these types of losses with the activities that maximize the overall effectiveness of equipment, process and plant through uncompromising elimination of 16 types of losses and improvement of performance. Focused Improvement activity is a priority in the TPM development programme with activities performed by cross-functional team. These teams identify and design activities to eliminate/ minimize the 16 losses, which are carefully measured and evaluated.
